In order to run a sports program at St. Mary's, we need many volunteers to help with various duties or we would not be able to have a sports program. Every parent is expected to help out in any way they can and you must sign up to help with something. **Coaches are needed for each team.** We cannot have a team unless we have a coach, therefore please consider coaching a team if you have the knowledge of the game or maybe you might know of someone that would be willing to coach.

Brief Descriptions of the various duties but not limited to the descriptions.

Coach: Sets up practices and teaches the game to the students. Assigns player positions and runs the team. Goes to every game and manages the team's players.

Assistant Coach: Helps the coach with team as the coach deems necessary.

Team Manager: Helps the coach set up the team's volunteer schedule for the games and is the person who contacts the parents about game changes and other team information. Does duties assigned by the coach.

Concessions: Help sell concessions at the home games. Sometimes it is for the game before, during, or after the teams scheduled game.

Collect Money at the door: Is the person who collects money at the door of home games from fans coming to see the game. You must be able to sit at the door during the whole game. Sometimes it will be before or after the scheduled home game.

Set-up: Help with setting up for the first game of the day. (Setting up scoreboard, pull out bleachers, put up benches and tables.) This duty is usually for someone who's team is playing the first game of the day.

Take down: Help with putting away the scoreboard, tables, and benches. This duty is usually for someone who's team is playing the last game of the day.

Clean-up Gym: Help with sweeping and mopping the gym floor and any other duty that needs to be done at the end of the day. This duty is usually for someone who's team is playing the last game of the day.

Any Duty: Where ever they need your help.
